Genesis Chapter 13

Opening Scripture: *“And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be. And he believed in the Lord; and he counted it to him for righteousness”*

-Genesis 15:5

DON'T “LOOK”, SEE

Matthew 13:13-15 says, “This is why I speak to them in parables: “Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand. In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah: “You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving. For this people’s heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them.”

In this scripture Jesus explains to the disciples why he spoke to the people in parables. Jesus said, “they have closed their eyes.” He is not talking about their physical eyes. He is referring to their spiritual eyes. They lack spiritual understanding. He says if only they could see with the eyes of the spirit, they would be healed. Therefore, don’t look at your present situation with your physical eyes. That will only give you the fact. Begin to see the solution through the eyes of faith. That will give you the truth.

SEE AND BELIEVE

In our opening scripture, God brought Abraham outside one night and told him to look at the stars and count them. This is significant because before God blessed him, he made sure Abraham had a mental picture of his future.
