## **TOPIC: THANKSGIVING**

**Philippians 4:6 “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God”**

Thanksgiving is expressing gratitude to God for the many blessings He has wrought in ones' life. People who know how to give thanks always increase. This means; they experience prosperity, success, growth and peace every day. They understand the Gods supremacy in their life and affairs. From time to time they take stock of all that has happened and give thanks; irrespective of the conditions around them.

All through scripture the place of thanksgiving and its importance are seen in the lives of outstanding and wealthy men. Jacob learned to always give thanks and even when in service he was seemingly not favored, God blessed Him. There are several ways to thank God for the increase in your life.

1. **Through Testimonies:** When you testify, you ascertain Gods' place and calling in your life. Also you are openly declaring your rights and inheritance in Christ. This shows you know who you are what you believe. Psalm 18:49, Psalm 1:9, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 4:15
2. **Through Seeds:** in giving you confirm that all you have belongs to God and undoubtedly affirm is superiority over your resources. This shows that Christ has dominion over all that matters and depicts your love for the master and his business. Thus you will never lack or want Psalm 23:1-2, 2 Samuel :11, Heb 11:7, Luke 7:37,
3. **Through Service:** As you render service to God, He constantly blesses you. The Levites served God and He provided for them, Caleb and Joshua, the prostitute Rahab, the small boy with the bread and fish, Mary and her sister, the church in Corinth all served God in different capacities and they all had a reason to testify. 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 9:12, 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 1:12, Deut. 1:25, 3<sup>rd</sup> John 1:12
