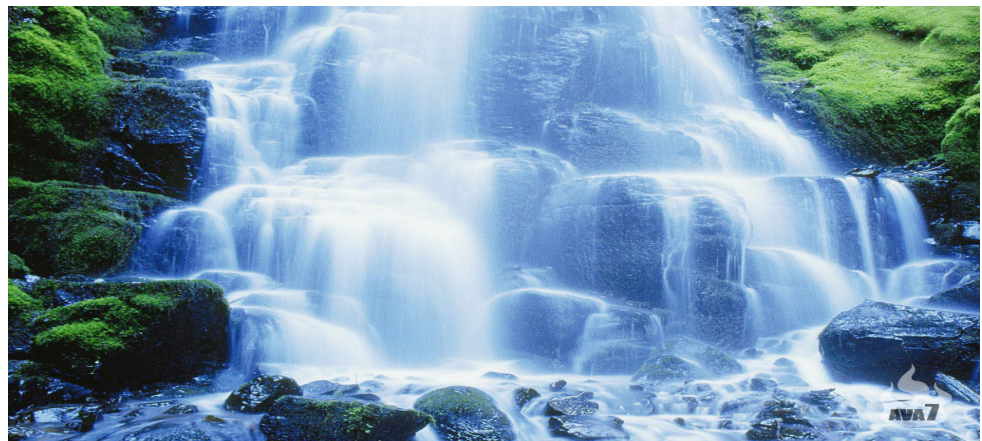
Pishon (Increase)

Genesis 2:10-12

Gihon (Bursting Forth)
